## Cookies & Crème Pudding Pops

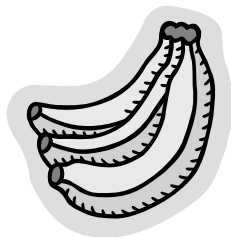
- 1 pkg (3.9 oz) chocolate instant pudding
- 2 cups cold milk
- 6 chocolate sandwich cookies
- 1/2 cup thawed whipped topping
- 9 small paper or plastic cups
- 9 wooden pop sticks or plastic spoons



Beat pudding mix and milk in large bowl, with whisk for 2 minutes. Place cookies in a resealable plastic bag, use a rolling pin to crush cookies. Add cookies and whipped topping to pudding and stir until blended. Spoon into 9 small paper or plastic cups. Insert wooden pop stick or plastic spoon into each cup for a handle. Freeze for 5 hours or until firm.

## Grilled Bananas

- Bananas
- Brown Sugar
- Lemon juice
- Cinnamon
- Butter
- Aluminum foil



Cut the bananas crosswise into 1/2 inch wide slices and place the slices in the center of an 18 inch long piece of aluminum foil. Then sprinkle the bananas with 2 tsp of brown sugar, 1/2 tsp lemon juice and a dash of cinnamon. Dot the bananas with 1/2 Tbsp butter cut into pieces. Fold the aluminum foil tight around the bananas and place over a warm grill and let cook for 15 to 30 minutes. Remove packets and carefully open the foil. Let it cool then serve.
