



Northern Paper Mills Credit Union will award a \$500 scholarship for the 2012-2013 academic year.

Scholarship Application Instructions and Requirements

1. **Applicant must be a Northern Paper Mills Credit Union member** in good standing with no delinquent loans, overdrawn accounts or charged off accounts at the time the award is given. If applicant does not have an account, contact the credit union for more details on how to join.
2. Applicant must attend an accredited university, college or trade school full time during the 2012-2013 academic year, and the funds must be used during this year.
3. Credit Union employees, officers, volunteers, and members of their households are not eligible. Immediate family members of employees, officers, and volunteers are not eligible.
4. Applicant must be a high school graduate in 2012 (or before) and have at least a 2.5 grade point average.
5. Scholarship application must be completed in its entirety; incomplete applications will be disqualified.
6. Scholarship funds will be held by NPM Credit Union until written verification is received from the school registrar where the student is enrolled full-time. Upon written verification, the winner's check will be made payable to both the winner and the college.
7. Winner must agree to allow NPM Credit Union to use his/her name and photograph for promotional use.
8. **Application must be received by April 6, 2012.** The winner will be selected from qualifying applications. The scholarship recipient will be contacted and the results announced at the Annual Meeting, April 14, 2012.
